## **PEER REVIEW POLICY**

Peer review is the process to uphold the quality and validity of the published articles.

Technology Forces Journal uses double-blind peer review policy to ensure only high-quality publications are selected for the journal. Papers are referred to at least two experts as suggested by the editorial board. All publication decisions are made by the journal's Editors-in-Chief on the basis of the referees' reports. We expect our board of reviewing editors and reviewers to treat manuscripts as confidential material. The identities of the authors and reviewers remain confidential throughout the process.

### **Information for Authors**

Authors need to register with the journal prior to submitting or, if already registered, can simply log in and begin the five-step process.

### **Submission Preparation Checklist**

As part of the submission process, authors are required to check off their submission's compliance with all of the following items, and submissions may be returned to authors that do not adhere to these guidelines.

- The submission has not been previously published, nor is it before another journal for consideration (or an explanation has been provided in Comments to the Editor).
- The submission file is in OpenOffice, Microsoft Word, RTF, or WordPerfect document file format.
- Where available, URLs for the references have been provided.



- The text is single-spaced; uses a 12-point font; employs italics, rather than underlining (except with URL addresses); and all illustrations, figures, and tables are placed within the text at the appropriate points, rather than at the end.
- The text adheres to the stylistic and bibliographic requirements outlined in the Author Guidelines, which is found in About the Journal.
- If submitting to a peer-reviewed section of the journal, the instructions in Ensuring a Blind Review have been followed.

## **ORIGINALITY AND PLAGIARISM POLICY**

The journal has a zero-tolerance policy towards plagiarism. All manuscripts are screened for plagiarism using the Turnitin Plagiarism software. As per HEC guidelines, all manuscripts should have a similarity index of less than 15%. Authors are requested to read the HEC plagiarism policy. Its link is as follows:

There is no fee for publishing articles in the Technology Forces Journal.

## **CORRECTION AND RETRACTION OF RESEARCH ARTICLES**

Once a manuscript is published, no changes can be made unless in exceptional circumstances. Corrections may be allowed to rectify unintentional mistakes and technical errors in the published papers. The published papers may be retracted if there is clear evidence of fraudulent/unethical practices. The copyright infringement or non-disclosure of conflict interest may also result in retraction of the published papers. The decision of correction or retraction will be made on case to case basis as per the policy. The decision of the Editorial board with regard to correction or retraction will be final and cannot be challenged.

## **ETHICAL GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS**

1. The authors must declare that the submitted manuscript has not been published elsewhere.
2. Authors must not submit the manuscript in any other journal while it is in the review process at this journal.
3. Authors must declare that they do not have any conflict of interest.
4. The corresponding author must ensure that all the authors have contributed to the submitted article. The corresponding author must also ensure that the author sequence of the manuscripts finalized with the consent of all co-authors.
5. The manuscript must contain the full names, email addresses, designation, and affiliation of all authors.
6. If the authors have received funds for the submitted article, they must clearly state it at the end of the manuscript.
7. The copyright of the published manuscript stays with the authors. However, the content of the published manuscript can be used with proper citation.

## **DISTRIBUTION OF TECHNOLOGY FORCES JOURNAL COPIES**

## **AUTHOR AGREEMENT FORM**

It is inconvenient for them to sign author agreement form, therefore, like many international journals, we send the final draft for proofreading to all the authors, with the advice to check the content in the manuscript before publication. The journal also advises authors to cross-check their names, designations, and institutional affiliations.
